- Perform gap analysis between available vendor service/technology, capabilities and existing innovative solutions, based on study needs, pain points, risks, opportunities and critical success factor
- Drive frontloading & planning, assessment and value driven adoption of internal & external system/tool/innovation in clinical studies
- Significant impact on the organization by driving the implementation/adoption of solutions with great impact in productivity and alignment within systems and operating models in Novartis

Essential Requirements:

- This position will be located at either the Cambridge, MA or East Hanover, NJ site and will not have the ability to be located remotely. This position will require approximately 2-5% travel as defined by the business (domestic and/ or international).
- 7+ years of professional experience in life science or pharma industry.
- Minimum 3 years of experience in leadership and project management.
- Minimum of a master 's degree.
- Strong knowledge of clinical trial processes, drug development and Good Clinical Practice.
- Proven leadership skills and demonstrated ability to lead complex projects.
- Good understanding of process flows. Capability for innovation and critical thinking that challenge the status quo.
